1 March 2019	National Allocation Day <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Herts County Council will email you the school you have been allocated, if you applied online and confirmed your email address. The online allocation system will be updated with allocations and be made available only after allocation emails have been sent• Notification letters will be posted first class only to parents or carers who applied on paper• If you applied online, you can use online facilities including appeals
1 – 15 March 2019	Continuing interest lists are created <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Applicants that did not get any higher preference schools will automatically go on the list for those schools• Parents or carers should confirm this with schools responsible for their own admissions
1 – 8 March 2019	Continuing interest applications open <ul style="list-style-type: none">• There are a small number of Hertfordshire schools that will accept new preferences for the first continuing interest run. Please see www.hertsdirect.org/admissions for details from 1 March 2019
15 March 2019	Last date for accepting the place offered <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Online applicants must accept the place online• Paper applicants should return their response form to the Admissions and Transport team
18 – 22 March 2019	First continuing interest run <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Herts County Council will contact you with an offer of a new school place, if you are successful at this first continuing interest run
25 March – 5 April 2019	Continuing interest applications open again <ul style="list-style-type: none">• You can add new school preferences for the second continuing interest run
29 March 2019 (by 4pm)	Last date to register an appeal
5 April 2019	Last date to register a change of preferences or for new applications to be added for the second continuing interest run
22– 26 April 2019	Second (and final) continuing interest run <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Herts County Council will contact you with an offer of a new school place, if you are successful at this second continuing interest run
May – August 2019	If school vacancies occur, places will be filled from remaining continuing interest lists.
3 May – 21 June 2019	School place appeals take place during this period
25 July 2019	Continuing interest for secondary schools close on 24 July 2019. To retain your continuing interest, you will need to make an in year application.
