Job Description



This is a **fantastic leadership opportunity** to help support students in Year 7 or 8. As a year 10 mentor, your role will be to work with another student in one form time per week (Monday for Yr 7, Tuesday for Yr 8). Often they will ask for advice on issues they are having with friends or at home or for you to actively provide additional support and motivation to help them succeed here at STAGS.

The **most important** aspects of this post are linked to your ability to be able to be a role model of how students should behave here at STAGS and genuinely listening to and caring for another.

The following is a list of specific tasks and responsibilities:

- To be a role model in terms of attitude, work ethic, manners and appearance to all members of the school community
- To support and actively listen to your student mentee through-out the year
- To report any concerning information your mentee shares immediately with Mrs Lalor or Mrs Parrett;
- To help coordinate whole school activities for the Time to Change campaign and Time to Talk Day
- To support Mrs Wheatley and the PSHCE team
- To attend Student Voice as required
- To attend the classes equipped with your own ideas and sufficient resources
- To assist and attend School functions as required e.g. Open Evening
- To wear the Mentor badge
- To carry out any other duties as required
